DAY TRIPS

ACTIVITY LEVELS

Mild: Some walking

Moderate: Walking with limited seating and steps

Strenuous: Walking on incline or uneven surfaces; no seating available

EXCURSION/TRIP CHAPERONES

The duty of the trip chaperone is to take a head count, distribute tickets and assist in case of an emergency. Chaperones cannot provide one-on-one assistance.

Trip participants are expected to be able to function independently, both physically and mentally. If you require individual assistance you may bring someone to help you. All participants and helpers must register and buy a ticket.

REFUNDS

Day trip refunds are provided if you cancel at least seven days in advance of the trip. If your trip or activity required advance purchase of tickets, we issue a refund only if we are able to re-sell your reservation to a patron on the waiting list. If we are unable to re-sell your ticket, you are responsible for the cost.

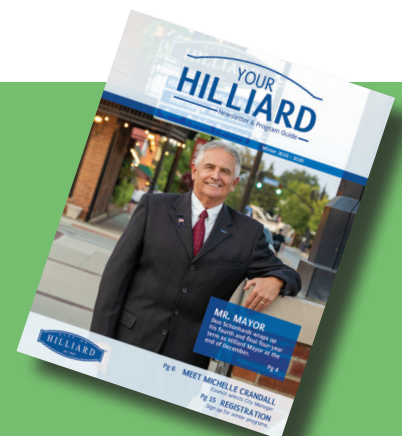
