ORDER

Extension of Closure of Municipal Buildings, Cancellation of Events, & Employees Working from Home

On November 19, 2020, Executive Orders 2020-EO-030 and 2020-EO-031 were issued regarding the closure of Municipal Buildings, Cancellation of Events and Work from Home for employees through Monday, January 18, 2021. This order was extended through January 31, 2021 by Executive Order 2021-EO-001.

Due to updated orders and guidance from local and state officials, it is necessary to extend these Orders through April 2, 2021.

All requirements outlined in 2020-EO-030, 2020-EO-031, and 2020-EO-001 are extended through April 2, 2021, including the requirement of masks/face coverings and social distancing when attending public meetings and the guidelines for all employees working at municipal facilities.

Limited programming at the City's Community Center and Senior Center will continue to be offered, included drive-thru lunches for senior citizens, blood drives, assistance with taxes for seniors, and limited outdoor activities. However, all other events, activities, or classes offered by the City are cancelled through April 2, 2021. Refunds will be issued to those individuals who have already paid for the event, activity, or class.
