Registration opens Monday, June 13

July 1 - Bluebird Days of Summer Lunch & Tour (11:00 a.m.)

Reg. Deadline: 6/24 Fee: Free Activity Level: Mild

Bluebird Retirement will transport participants on their 12-passenger bus from the Hilliard Senior Center to their facility in Marysville. Eat lunch, take a tour, play a game, then return to the Hilliard Senior Center by 3 p.m. Limited to the first 12 participants.

July 6 - Trolley Tour of Marietta and Tonya's Country Kitchen (8:00 a.m.)

Reg. Deadline: 6/29 Fee: \$7 at signup; \$15 cash day of trip Activity Level: Moderate

Eat first at Tonya's Country Kitchen. Then take a Trolley Tour and learn all there is to enjoy in beautiful, historic Marietta. Your guide tells stories about the early pioneers who founded Marietta and introduces you to this historic town at the confluence of the Ohio and Muskingum Rivers. Tour highlights include Victorian Front Street Shops, First Congregational Church, Start Westward Monument, Johnson Meigs Home, Ohio River Museum, W.P Snyder JR., Campus Martius Museum, David Putnam House, Historic Harmar, Henry Fearing Museum, Mound Cemetery, Marietta College, The Castle Museum, and Historic Churches.

July 7 - Hollywood Casino (9:30 a.m.)

July 12 - Bear's Mill and Vint's Family Restaurant (8:00 a.m.)

Reg. Deadline: 7/5 Fee: \$6 at signup; \$6 day of trip; lunch OYO Activity Level: Strenuous

Take a docent lead tour of Bear's Mill in Greenville, one of the few operating water-powered mills in Ohio. Built in 1849, its grand framework is constructed of exquisite hand hewn timber beams that are nearly 50 feet long, without a single splice. The Mill still grinds grain into flours and meals today, using the same cool grind practices as old world millers. Coffee, bottled water, and a homemade cookie will be served at the end of the tour, and each visitor will take home a sample bag of stoneground product with a recipe. Bear's Mill is four stories with no elevators. If you cannot walk up the stairs, there are interesting things to see on the first floor, including the Mill Store & Gallery. There is no heat or air conditioning outside the first floor, so dress appropriately for the weather. Afterwards, eat lunch at Vint's Family Restaurant.

July 13 - Westcott House and Studebaker's Country Restaurant (9:30 a.m.)

Reg. Deadline: 7/6 Fee: \$6 at signup; \$17 day of trip; lunch OYO Activity Level: Strenuous

Tour Frank Lloyd Wright's Westcott House in Springfield. The Westcott House was designed in 1906 and built in 1908. In the early 1940s, the interior alterations—the conversion of the open floor plan into a multi-unit apartment building—changed the architecture so significantly that it no longer reflected the design intent of its architect. Due to these drastic alterations, the Westcott House remained an undiscovered relic for many years - a lost Wright artifact. Through the cooperative efforts of the Frank Lloyd Wright Building Conservancy and the Westcott House Foundation, today the Westcott House is an important rediscovery, a notable, newly-unearthed and revitalized example of Wright's legacy. Afterwards, eat lunch at Studebaker's Country Restaurant. Stop at Schuler's Bakery on the way home for some sweet treats!

July 18 - Airstream Factory Tour and Homecoming Family Restaurant (9:30 a.m.)

Reg. Deadline: 7/11 Fee: \$6 at signup, \$3 cash day of trip Activity Level: Strenuous

If you've ever wondered how Airstreams are made, there's no better way to find out than to come see for yourself. The Airstream Factory Tour is an in-depth walkthrough of their actual production facility in Jackson Center. See how they carefully craft, rivet, and build their travel trailers by hand. Closed toed shoes are required, safety glasses will be provided, and you'll sign a waiver before the tour begins. Once the tour is finished, continue to their museum, the Airstream Heritage Center. After leaving Airstream, eat lunch at Homecoming Family Restaurant in Bellefontaine.

July 19 - Senior Day at the Franklin County Fair (8:00 a.m.)

Senior Day is back and will include a pancake breakfast from Chris Cakes, Singo, entertainment, prizes, and lunch! Norwich Township Firefighters, City of Hilliard Police Officers, volunteers, and sponsors will join in the fun. The bus shuttle will begin running at 8 a.m., and will continue running until everyone has returned after the event ends at 1 p.m. \$8 purchases your ticket, and the bus is free this day.

July 26 - Queen of the Lake III and Papa Boos (9:00 a.m.)**

Reg. Deadline: 7/19 Fee: \$6 at signup; \$22 cash day of trip; lunch OYO Activity Level: Moderate

Take a historical tour of Buckeye Lake aboard the Queen of the Lake III! The Buckeye Lake Historical Society Museum finished their restoration project of the Queen of the Lake III in 2021, and the 88 foot sternwheeler is now cruising the lake's shores. The 5 year project had hundreds of hours of restoration and over 50 volunteers who turned the river boat into a 55 plus passenger tour boat. The boat donated by Dr. Ronald and Cindy Downing of Malta in June of 2015 was hauled up from the Muskingum River then drydocked at the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club for 4 years while its restoration began. It was then moved to Buckeye Lake Marina for its completion. Take a 90-minute boat tour, then eat lunch at Papa Boos.
