- HiFiO is a 30-mile fiber optic network, creating more connections between broadband providers and businesses in Hilliard.
- The network is owned by the City of Hilliard, which invested \$4 million into its construction.
- HiFiO is carrier-neutral, which provides more competition among high-speed internet providers.
- HiFiO is available to businesses of all sizes, residents, and schools.
