View *The Troll That Hatched an Egg* exhibit, one of only nine exhibits in the United States created by world-renowned recycle artist, Thomas Dambo. The giant trolls, Bo, Bodil and Bibbi, and their troll-sized bird nest are made from locally sourced recyclable materials and are a permanent exhibit created especially for Aullwood Audubon. The wooden trolls are expected to remain intact for approximately five years until they decompose and return to the earth. Begin your visit at the Nature Center, where you'll find interactive displays, educational games, animals, the Nature Store and Gift Shop, and more, plus you'll be able to see two of the trolls from this side of the property.
