Current Exhibits: "See Anyone You Know? The New Yorker Cartoons and Covers of Edward Koren" For over fifty years, Edward Koren's whimsical, hirsute, and anthropomorphic creatures made him one of The New Yorker's most recognizable and beloved cartoonists. Through his playful illustrations, Koren captured cultural trends, social dynamics, and environmental concerns while documenting the quirks and follies of human nature. "The Lone Crusader: Larry Ivie and Fandom in the Golden Age of Comics" Larry Ivie may no longer be a household name, but in the 1950s and 60s, he was a cornerstone of comic book fandom. Born in 1936, two years before Superman's debut, Ivie dedicated his life to preserving the history of comic books. As a collector, historian, writer, artist, and passionate fan, he forged meaningful connections with creators and readers, leaving an enduring legacy in the world of comics.
