This Copper Shop, where work was began in 1874, is the last of the Old Copper Shops in America still making its original product – Applebutter Kettles – primarily by hand. Commercially it produces, in addition to Applebutter Kettles, Candy and Caramel Corn Kettles, and Tympani. After, we will head to The Pickwick Place to explore restored barns with vendor stalls, a cafe, and U-pick fruits and vegetables on a former horse farm and have lunch OYO at the café.

Head just north of Columbus to explore The Olentangy Indian Caverns! A series of caves, natural passages and rooms occupying three different levels, the caverns were formed millions of years ago by an underground river that cut through the limestone rock. There are 58 steps down into the cave and the stairs and cave floor are cemented for safety reasons; however, rainwater is always seeping through the ground. **Safe, comfortable shoes with non-slip soles are required to enter.** After the caverns, we will head north to Waldo, OH to the G&R Tavern, famous for their fried bologna sandwiches and homemade pies.

The experience also includes an overview of acceptable and unacceptable materials, an explanation of Rumpke's recycling operations, and an opportunity to ask questions. As part of our collaboration with COSI, the Rumpke Recycling & Resource Center in Columbus, OH, features a newly designed education center with interactive exhibits. The center provides a unique, hands-on learning experience, allowing visitors to explore the recycling process from start to finish—highlighting how everyday items are repurposed into new products.
